## Dressing for Dinner

$\square$ 2-3 casual pants
$\square 1$ dress/suit pants

- 5 short sleeve collared shirt
- 1 dress shirt
$\square$ 1-2 ties and/or jacket for elegant night.
$\square$ Belt
- Dress socks
*There are typically 2 "Elegant" nights on a 7 -night cruise.


## Shoes

$\square$ 1-2 comfortable dress shoes that coordinate with your dinner attire. Shoes are big/clunky so if you can coordinate your dress clothes to match one pair of dress shoes, great!
$\square$ Sneakers/socks
$\square$ Sandals and or flip flops -add water shoes if you are going on a water excursions or visiting a known rocky beach.

Around the Ship/Ports of Call/Other
$\square 5-7$ shorts
$\square$ 7-9 mix and match tops (a couple extra in case of feeling sweaty or a spill)
12 Underwear (changing after swimming, for dinner, etc. you will want extra)
$\square$ loungewear

Beach/Pool
$\square$ 2-3 swimsuits - humid climates make air drying times longer
$\square$ Hat
Sunglasses
$\square$ Bag for personal items at pool/beach
$\sqsupset$ Phone pouch to protect against water and sand damage

- Water bottle
*Towels are available on the ship and can be checked out for use on the islands



## Toiletries

$\square$ Sunscreen
$\square$ Skin care/Dopp kit
$\square$ Deodorant
$\square$ Hair/shave products
$\square$ Shampoo/Conditioner and Bodywash
$\square$ Dental care
$\square$ Medication - include a few standard medicine cabinet items such as Ibuprofen, cold medicine, seasickness medicine \& stomach medicine. General medicine on board is expensive.
